This Sunday, August 23rd - Our summer series "Bible Greats" continues with a study of the Four Lepers found in 2 Kings 6 and 7. This little known story comes from the 9th century BC during a war between the northern kingdom of Israel and the nation of Syria. Elisha is the prophet at the time. The capital city of Samaria has been under siege and the situation has become desperate. Starvation has driven the people to cannibalism. That is where God steps in to deliver his people in a most unusual way and uses these lepers as messengers. Even though the Bible does not record the names of these four men, their story contains a powerful illustration of the good news of the Gospel and the responsibility that comes with such a great treasure.
